The white 2019 Picarana comes from a warm and very low-yielding year when they harvested in July (28th), their earliest to date because the vines suffered frost and then it was extremely dry and warm. This has a Mediterranean nose of dry straw and waxy apples, a little in the style of a Garnacha Blanca, with a round palate and mellow acidity, with moderate alcohol, around 13%, as the ripeness was blocked because of the heat and drought, tasty flavors and a long dry finish. It feels polished and ready, a little more evolved than expected, developing some notes of pollen, honey and caramel as the wine sat in the glass. 11,000 bottles produced.
